- 3.0 GPA cumulative or higher
- Must be a Student Athlete
- College/Vocational School Acceptance Letter
- Minimum 500-word essay in word format
  - o Explain your future college/vocational and career goals
- Interview with the scholarship committee

### **Award Notification**

Students will be notified if they will be receiving one of the scholarships. Students will need to attend the Miyamura Senior Awards Night to receive the Award of the scholarship.

### **Requirements of the Recipients**

The scholarship funds will be sent to the institution in the designated student's name. Student will not receive any money directly.

Student must complete require paperwork including a form about the Institution student is attending and a 1099 for income reporting.

The following award criteria was provided by Mr. Hershey Miyamura at the inception of this scholarship award program. Courage, honor, selfless service, duty, respect, and integrity are part of the hallmark US Army values and what Mr. Miyamura lived during his life. Apply the mentioned values and please read the first page and fill in the remaining pages and send or return them to your counselor.

#### **Award Criteria**

- A. All applicants must be in the current class of Hiroshi Miyamura High School graduating seniors.
- B. The applicant must have a financial need to help pay for a post-secondary education in the moderate to low family income category. Those with a full-ride scholarships should not apply, be considerate of those that would benefit from this grant.
- C. The recipients will need to enroll within a year from their graduation in a four (4) year college/university or Trade School program in order to receive the scholarship award. See the next line for military only deferment option.
- D. The scholarship award must be claimed within a maximum of one (1) year from the recipient's High School graduation. McKinley Education Foundation will not extend or delay the award issuance beyond the one year period. However, deferment for Military obligation will be considered by the McKinley Education Board with a letter from recruiting office and/or a copy of your discharge record (DD form 214) from the Military. Those given a deferment for Military obligation have one (1) year from their separation from the military to enroll in a four (4) year college/university or Trade School program in order to receive the scholarship award.
- E. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 based on a four-point scale over seven semesters. All high school courses will be included in the GPA calculation.
- F. The scholarship award or amount that will be given to each recipient is a one-time only grant. The money can be used until the funds from the award are expended from the recipient's student account for tuition, books, supplies, housing or necessary educational items.
- G. The McKinley Education Board reserves the right to add, change or modify the above criteria as necessary.

#### **Award Procedure**

- A. The Scholarship award money will be sent to the institution where the recipient will be attending classes and placed into their student account. The recipient must return the basic information form to McKinley Education Foundation as to where they will be attending school along with their institution issued student id number. Without this necessary information the McKinley Education Foundation Treasurer cannot complete the processing of the award.
- B. Individual \$2000 (or greater) scholarship awards will be given to three (3) selected applicants who are graduating seniors from Hiroshi Miyamura High School. *The McKinley Education Foundation board shall determine the amount per award or the quantity of recipients based on funds available in Miyamura scholarship account that it administrates.*
- C. There is no restriction on the number of applicants who may apply at the school, however the principal or counselor at the school may set a limit.
- D. The selection committee is appointed by the principal at the School. The School Scholarship Committee can be composed of the head counselor, a school administrator, and 3 principal-appointed staff members, however this will be left up to the discretion of the principal at the school. This committee shall select the scholarship recipients by conducting a vetting process of all the submitted student applications. The final selection of recipients will determined from the information provided in this application form relative to the award criteria.
- E. When the Scholarship committee determines the scholarship recipients, the names of the recipients must be sent to McKinley Education Foundation Treasurer. The Scholarship winners can and should be announced at the High School awards assembly.
- F. Answer all items on the form, when completed, print & return/email this application to your school counselor prior to the designated deadline date and time as determined by the Scholarship Committee, principal or counselor.
